Clean Hands Make Healthy Kids!

During cold and flu season it is especially important to keep our hands clean! - Wash hands thoroughly with soap after playing, after toileting, and before eating. (Without guidance most children will simply put soap on their hands and then rinse it off without really washing.)
- Cover your cough or sneeze with your elbow - not your hand. This will take some practice.
- Avoid touching your face, especially your mouth, as much as possible.
- Do not put toys or other objects in your mouth.

We Want Your Trash!

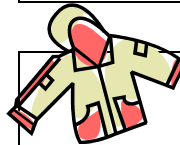


We use all kinds of recyclable items in the art room and throughout the school. Right now we specifically need:
